### ***Education and Experience***

Jennifer M. Mansur earned her Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the International Institute of Chinese Medicine in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in August, 2002. This four-year program consisted of 3,500 hours of education, including over 1,000 hours of clinical practice. She was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in January, 2007. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique. During the last year of training, Jennifer interned at the Chengdu Hospital of Integrated Traditional Chinese Medicine and Western Medicine, Chengdu, China; St. Vincent Regional Medical Center in Santa Fe, New Mexico; and HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Jennifer's training includes adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, Tui Na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, Kinesio Taping, and dietary and lifestyle recommendations. She is a licensed acupuncturist in Colorado. None of these licenses, certificates, or registrations has ever been suspended or revoked.

This clinic complies with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Colorado Department of Health, including the proper cleaning and sterilization of needles and the sanitation of acupuncture offices. Only single-use, disposable, factory-sterilized needles are utilized. Discounted services provided for members off the practitioner's customary charges for insurance billing.
